It also does not mean that you have to see this GP each time you visit the surgery, as this will not always be possible.

BLOOD PRESSURE CHECKS

Please make sure you have all your travel vaccinations up to date. Please allow enough time before travelling to complete the vaccinations courses. The vaccinations will be given by our Practice Nurses, and as they are very busy please make sure you book in with enough time to complete the vaccination courses.
